The reading of the minutes of the last meeting of the Members and Directors was on motion, duly made and seconded, waived and the minutes were unanimously approved as corrected.

Robert L. Timmons, the Treasurer, presented financial reports analyzing the calendar year 1984 financial operations. After a full discussion, participated in by all, the 1984 report was unanimously approved and was, by the Chairlady, ordered made a part of the financial records of the Foundation.

The Treasurer circulated amongst the Directors and Members a statement of the assets of the Foundation as of May 31, 1985, which had been prepared by the First National Bank and Trust Company of Joplin, Missouri, as agent for the Foundation under an agreement

dated January 3, 1984. The essential, non-technical portions thereof were as follows:

The agency report with its detailed schedules was carefully analyzed and discussed. Upon motion, duly made and seconded, it was approved and ordered made a part of the financial records of the Foundation.

A proposed increase in the number of Directors of the Foundation was then discussed. The Members were advised that a revision of Section 3 of Article V of the By-Laws would be required if the number were increased. After a full discussion, participated in by all, it was, on motion, duly made and seconded, resolved as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED that Section 3, Article V of the By-Laws of the Foundation be amended and in its place and stead, effective as of the date of this resolution, a new Section 3, Article V be and it is herewith enacted. It is in word and figures as follows:

Section 3, Article V. The Board of Directors of the Foundation shall be twelve in number and shall be elected annually by the Members to serve until the next annual meeting of the Directors and Members or until their successors are duly elected and have qualified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the twelve-person Board of Directors shall be restricted to three members to be elected from the George S. Timmons family, three from the Robert L. Timmons family, three from the Judith T. Spears family, plus three independent Directors, one of which shall be Bess Spiva Timmons during her lifetime, and one shall be an attorney to act as general counsel, and another Director would be an independent advisor elected by the Members.

In conformity with the newly enacted and amended By-Laws, the following Directors were nominated and unanimously elected to serve until the next annual meeting of the Members or until their successors were duly elected and qualified:

There being no other or further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and seconded, the meeting was adjourned and the Officers undertook considerations and analysis of pending applications for donations.
